

KENYA

A ride that crosses through Amboseli en route to the Chyulu Hills. The snow-capped peaks of Kilimanjaro being a constant throughout the ride, the actual distance covered will be some 90 miles although this varies depending on the distance/time factors spent exploring the bush. Accommodation is by private camps and lodges.



Done at an adventurous pace, this is an itinerary for competent, advanced riders. A 10-night itinerary that begins with you being picked up from Nairobi airport and transferred to your first campsite, this then goes on, with you travelling towards Amboseli, perhaps crossing the Kenyan border to explore the foot of Mt Kilimanjaro, continuing towards Chyulu Hills and

incorporates early morning stalks before ending the journey in Laikipia.

You have the option of extending your journey in Laikipia with a few nights on the star beds of Loisaba- one of the definitive experiences in East Africa, or continue onwards to Lamu for a beach retreat.

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WHAT TO BRING

Clothes :

- Jodpurs, Minimum of two pairs
- Half Chaps, To wear with Jodpurs
- Leather Chaps, Alternative to Jodpurs
- Light Cotton Trousers, To wear under chaps and or evenings
- Shorts, For the midday break
- Long sleeve shirt



- Optional: Protection from the sun while riding
- T Shirts
- Swim suit
- Kikoi or Sarong
- Socks, 2 changes per day (laundry is done daily except on camp moves)
- Rubber Flip Flops, 1 pair
- Riding Shoes, 1 pair

- Trainers, 1 pair or shoes to wear when not riding
- Slacks or similar for evenings
- Sweat shirt
- Money Belt or Cotton Waist and Warm Jacket
- Lightweight Jacket
- Hat, Hard for riding if preferred, wide brim / straw for shade



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- Riding Gloves
- Plastic Poncho, Rainy season

All clothes should be neutral, khaki or bush coloured for riding and walking.

Other :

- Sunglasses



- Suntan and Blockout lotion
- Lip ice
- Insect repellent
- Antihistamine cream and pills
- Bumbag (Fanny Pack)
- Camera, film, binoculars
- Water Bottle
- Head torch - torches and spare batteries.
- First Aid Kit

Trip Grading/Difficulty:

Flights

Health

You are strongly advised to contact your own GP or vaccination centre in respect of required vaccinations for Kenya. Check on recommended immunizations as least a month before travel. Among the items you might pack are: sun creams (factor 12 and above), insect repellent, sting relief cream, antiseptic cream, a lightweight hat and sunglasses.

Important Note

Trip itineraries are subject to revision due to weather, road and trail conditions, government restrictions and other factors beyond our control.

Booking Conditions:

Booking your tailor-made holiday

A booking is accepted only after we receive the completed signed booking form and/or the non-refundable deposit required. If the booking is made within 60 days of departure, then full payment is required at the time of confirmation except over the Christmas & New Year period when the full itinerary amount must be made at the time of booking. The balance of payment due for your travel arrangements must be paid by you not later than 60 days before departure; otherwise we may treat the booking as cancelled.

Methods of payment

Payments for deposits and final monies for Travel Arrangements may be made by bank transfer.

Cancellation

All cancellations must be advised in writing and will take effect the day we receive it. Urbane Nomads refunds all recoverable costs after cancellation, subject to third-party cancellation and refund policies and a USD500 administration and travel planning fee.

In some cases hotels require prepayment in full for hotel rooms and services in the peak period. In such cases these deposits are non refundable.

Travel Insurance

It is a condition of booking the Travel Arrangements that You are adequately insured for the full duration of the your travel arrangements in respect of illness, injury, death, loss of baggage and personal items, cancellation and curtailment.
